The Bengaluru MSW Limited (BML) has filed a petition vide O.P No. 20 of 2016, for determination of Tariff by the Hon'ble Karnataka Electricity Regulatory Commission (KERC) for the energy to be generated from 11.5 MW Municipal Solid Waste (MSW) based Power plant located at Giddenhalli, Bengaluru.

The energy so generated is proposed to be sold to the Distribution Licensees in Karnataka, as per Gol Tariff Policy dated 28th January 2016 and in terms of Clause 9 of KERC (Power Procurement from Renewable Sources by Distribution Licensee and Renewable Energy Certificate Framework) Regulation 2011. The Hon'ble Commission has admitted the said petition on 31st March, 2016.
